- 1.3 Open C (participants: ELO lower than 1800)
- 1.4 Open D (participants: ELO lower than 1400)
- 1.5 1<sup>st</sup> Open Blitz
- 1.6 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Blitz
- 1.7 Boys under 10 (Date of birth 2009 and after)
- 1.8 Girls under 10 (Date of birth 2009 and after)
- 1.9 Boys under 8 (Date of birth 2011 and after)
- 1.10 Girls under 8 (Date of birth 2011 and after)

### 2. System and Rate of Play

#### 2.1 Time Control:

- **Open A** - Playing time: 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.
- **Open B, Open C, Open D, U10, U8 B&G** - 90 minutes plus 30 seconds per move.

#### 2.2 Festival tournaments system: 9 rounds played in the Swiss system.

#### 2.3 Pairings will be carried out with the computer program – **SwissManager**.

4.3 In age tournaments: best results U7 and U9 girls and boys will be awarded cups and diplomas.
