<u>Time Control</u>: 3min + 1sec/move, 18 rounds Blitz Chess, Swiss System.

Score Calculation: A win is worth one point, a draw is a half point, and a loss is zero points. When a player can't be paired during a round, they receive a "bye" which worth one point.

How is the winner decided?

The player(s) with the most points at the conclusion of the tournament will be announced winner(s). When two or more players have the same number of points, Sonneborn–Berger score will be the tie break. Results and winners' names will be published after the final report.

Fair Play:

Qatar Chess Association has taken several measures to ensure clean and fair play system for all participants. QCA reserves the right to **BAN** x-player from taking part in any future tournament hosted by QCA and **declare** his name in public if x-player turn out to be cheating or using any external assistance like chess engines during the tournament.

If your lichess account is further convicted of fair-play violations, your account will be closed, and you will be subjected to lichess private proceedings. You can find more information about this on: lichess.org/faq
