- confirmed participants: Winner of the Open 2022 GM Alexander Motylev (names of other participants will be gradually announced)

- winner of the tournament will obtain the right to participate in MASTERS TOURNAMENT 2024

C) 20-30 June 2023: FUTURES - round-robin youth tournament

- round robin tournament for youths under 13 y.o.

- winner of the tournament will obtain the right to participate in OPEN TOURNAMENT 2024

D) 22-30 June 2023: open master tournament with GM norm

- 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2x 1,5 h/40 + 30 min + 30 s/move
- rating tournament with rating for ELO FIDE
- participation of players without age and ratings limitations
- waiting time 1 h in case of late arrival
- winner of the tournament will obtain the right to participate in CHALLENGERS TOURNAMENT 2024
- financial prizes in CZK:
- 1. 25 000, 2. 15 000, 3. 10 000, 4. 8 000, 5. 6000, 6. 5000, 7. 4000, 8. 3 000, 9. 2 000, 10. 2 000 (80 000 CZK altogether, 15% tax will be deducted from prizes in excess of 10 000 CZK)

- registration in advance is not possible.

G) 25 June 2023 open blitz tournament

- right of participation without limitations, rating for ELO FIDE
- 11 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 3 min/2 sec per move
- financial prizes in CZK: 1 500, 1000, 700, 500, 300, material prizes for other players
- starting fee: 4.5 EUR
- fees for rating of the tournament results for ELO in the amount of 0.5 EUR (or 10 CZK) per player are charged according to the Economic directive of the Chess Federation of the Czech Republic. They are not included in the starting fee and will be paid by participants during the registration.
- registration in advance is not possible.

H) 26 June 2023: open Fischer random chess tournament

- right of participation without limitations
- 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 10 min/5 sec per move
- financial prizes in CZK: 1 000, 700, 500, material prizes for other players
- starting fee: 5 EUR

- 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 10 min/5 sec per move
- financial prizes in CZK: 1 000, 700, 500, material prizes for other players

- registration in advance is not possible.

J) 28 June 2023: open Basque chess tournament

- right of participation without limitations
- 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 10 min/5 sec per move
- financial prizes in CZK: 1 000, 700, 500, material prizes for other players
- starting fee: 5 EUR
- registration in advance is not possible.

K) 29 June 2023: open Bughouse tournament

- right of participation without limitations
- playing system will be set on site, 2 x 2 min/2 sec per move (Bronstein)
- financial prizes in CZK: 1 000, 700, 500 (for pair), material prizes for other players
- starting fee: 10 EUR / pair
- registration in advance is not possible.

GRAND PRIX DON GIOVANNI 2023

The GRAND PRIX overall score will be calculated from results of tournaments A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K and daily quiz. A player reaching highest score will become the winner. Special prizes will be awarded at the closing ceremony on 30 June 2023 at 17.30.

- D, F, G, H, I, J: 1. number of points, 2. Buchholz Cut 1 (the result of an opponent with the lowest point profit is deducted), 3. Buchholz, 4. Sonnenborn-Berger, 5. the greater number of games played with black
- prizes in tournament D are distributed according to Hort system among such number of players which corresponds to the number of advertised prizes
