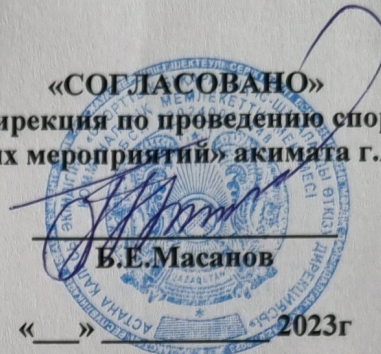

REGULATIONS

of the Astana Zhuldyzdary International Chess Festival

dedicated to the 25th anniversary of Astana as the capital of Kazakhstan

1. Official name

The Astana Zhuldyzdary International Chess Festival (hereinafter "the Festival").

2. Objectives

The purpose of the competition is:

- to popularize and develop chess in the Republic of Kazakhstan
- to promote a healthy lifestyle
- to improve athletes' skills and competencies,
- to provide opportunities for Kazakhstan to earn GM and IM chess title norms,
- to increase tournament participation for player of all levels: juniors, amateurs, and skilled players.

3. Tournament management

The general management of the Festival is the responsibility of the chief organizer, the Kazakhstan Chess Development Fund. The chess tournaments are directed by the arbiter board.

4. Tournament information

- 4.1. The competitions will be held in the city of Astana from July 10 (arrival day) to July 19 (departure day), 2023.
- 4.2. Festival venue: Astana Congress Center, 44 Sauran St, Astana 010000, Kazakhstan.

5. Format and system

5.1. Time control:

- 5.2. As per Art. 1.4.3.d of the FIDE International Title Regulations, it is possible to earn GM, IM, WGM and WIM title norms in the A Tournament.
- 5.3. All tournaments are played according to FIDE rules, using the Swiss system, and will be rated by FIDE.
- 5.4. The FIDE certified Swiss Manager tournament management software will be used for pairings.

- 6.2.** The round schedule may be adjusted by the arbiter board.
- 6.3.** The default time is thirty (30) minutes after the actual start of the round. If a player is more than 30 minutes late for his game, this game will result in a forfeit.

7. Appeal procedure

- 7.1.** In the Technical Meeting an Appeals Committee (AC) will be elected, consisting of the Chairman, two regular AC members, and two reserve AC members.
- 7.2.** A player or his registered representative may appeal any decision of the arbiter board by submitting an appeal in writing to the Appeals Committee no later than 30 minutes after the end of the last game of the round and by paying an appeal fee of 30,000 tenge
- 7.3.** Since the pairings are made by a FIDE-certified tournament management software, no appeals against the computer-generated pairings shall be accepted.
- 7.4.** The Appeals Committee decisions are final.
- 7.5.** If an appeal is granted, the appeal fee will be returned, otherwise it shall be forfeited to the Organizing Committee.

8. Participation & Registration

- 8.1.** Players shall meet the following requirements to participate in the Festival:

- 8.2.** The organizers will review the applications and selectively accept 20 grandmasters with a rating of 2550 and above under the following conditions: participants will be provided with double/single accommodation with full board plus travel expenses not exceeding \$500.
- 8.3.** All participants shall register by June 20, 2023. www.astanachessfestival.kz
- 8.4.** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to deny registration after June 20, 2023.
- 8.5.** Late participants who are not registered within the period stipulated by the Regulations can be included in the tournament by decision of the Chief Arbiter from the 2nd round (in the first round, such a participant is not paired and given 0 points)

9. Tie-Breaks. Prizes.

- 9.1.** The winners of each tournament are determined by the highest number of points scored. In case of a tie between two or more competitors, the following ti-break criteria are applied consecutively:
- 1) the Buchholz score Cut 1 (without one worst result)
 - 2) the Buchholz score
 - 3) higher number of victories
 - 4) direct encounter (if all players in that scoregroup played each other)
 - 5) the number of games played by the Black pieces
- 9.2.** The following types of prizes are established: medals and monetary prizes for 1st-3rd places, monetary prizes for 4th-10th (15th) places (see details below), medals and monetary prizes for the best three results in the individual categories of the participants (women, over 60 y.o., ... - see details below).
- 9.3.** In case of a tie between several competitors, the prize money will be divided equally. If a player is eligible for prizes in more than one category, the cash prizes are not added up; the competitor is given the right to choose one of the prizes. If this choice results in the participant losing the right to the cash prize, together with the medal, in any category, both the prize and the medal for that category shall go to the entrant who achieved the next best result.
- 9.4.** The prizes will be paid into the winners' bank accounts, with the cost of the payment being for the account of the recipient. Within one day after the results of the tournament have been announced, the winners will have to give the bank account details to the organizers.
- 9.5.** Taxes will be withheld from all prizes according to the current legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
- 9.6.** The total prize fund of the Festival is 40 000 000 tenge.

10. Dress Code and medical measures

The participants shall observe the FIDE dress code (no shorts, flip-flops, slippers, etc.).

11. Health measures

Participants are advised to wear a mask during the competition. A player may be excluded from the competition in case of fever or other symptoms.

12. Fair Play measures; electronic devices

As per the FIDE Anti-Cheating Guidelines, Tournament A is a competition with the second, increased, level of anti-cheating measures; Tournaments B, C, D are competitions with the third, standard, level of anti-cheating measures. The organizers and the arbiter board will apply protection measures corresponding to these levels.

In accordance with Art. 11.3.1 of the FIDE Laws of Chess, players are forbidden to have any electronic devices in the playing area without an express permission of an arbiter. Such devices may be kept in the player's bag, provided that the device is completely switched off, the bag is closed and the location of the bag has been agreed with the arbiters, and the player is not permitted to use the bag without the referee's permission. If a player has such a device with him in the playing area, his game shall be immediately forfeited and his opponent shall be awarded victory.

13. Financing

The prize fund, arbiters' honorariums, travel, accommodation and meals of the invited participants and invited arbiters are the organizers's responsibility. Participants travel and per diem expenses are their own responsibility..
