General Regulations





1. Inv tior

FIDE and the Oman Chess Committee invite all FIDE Member Federations and eligible players to participate in the FIDE World Amateur Chess Championships for Open and Women with a FIDE rating under 2300. In total, 6 (six) championship titles in 3 categories will be awarded: Open & Women Under 1700, Open & Women Under 2000, Open & Women Under 2300. The championships will be held in Muscat (Gulf of Oman). The dates are 01 of November (arrivals) to 11 of November 2023 (departures).









2. Playing Venue

The FIDE World Amateur Chess Championships will be held **in the Sultan Qaboos Complex**, while Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque is 7.8 km from the property.

4. Technical Regulations

4.1 Participants: There will be separate Championships for FIDE rating categories **Under 2300, Under 2000 & Under 1700.** There shall be separate Women's Championship(s) if there are at least ten (10) players from at least two (2) continents in each category. Otherwise, Women players will play in Open competition and, in this case of a merged tournament, women players will be eligible to win prizes from both categories: **For example,** if the 1st woman player also wins the 3rd place in the men (open) standings, she will receive both prizes in terms of any trophies, medals, prize money and qualification rights awarded.

4.2 a) The Championships are open for players registered by their national federation. FIDE member federations shall have the right to send as many players as they wish.

b) The Winners from each FIDE World Amateur Championship rating section and from each Continental Amateur Championship rating section, of the year preceding this edition, are invited with personal rights as long as they don't reach or exceed a FIDE rating of 2300 by the registration deadline, and their places cannot be substituted.

The Organizing Committee shall provide free board and lodging (twin rooms with bath and/or shower) for players qualified with personal rights from above article (4.2 b).

4.3 a) For participation in the **Under2300 section**, a player must not have a published FIDE rating of 2300 or greater for at least one year prior to the registration deadline (**1**st **September 2023**).

No player may hold any title above FM or WFM in the Under 2300 category.

b) For participation in the **Under 2000 section**, a player must not have a published FIDE rating of 2000 or greater for at least one year prior to the start of the championship.

c) For participation in the **Under 1700 section**, a player must not have a published FIDE rating of 1700 or greater for at least one year prior to the start of the championship.

d) No player may hold any title above CM or WCM in the Under 1700 and Under 2000 categories. No player may hold any title above FM or WFM in the Under 2300 category.

These restrictions will not apply to players whose age makes them eligible to participate in that year's World Seniors 65+ category.

4.4 a) The Championships will be held according to FIDE tournament Rules and Laws of Chess.b) The tournaments will be played using the Swiss System with 9 rounds.







c) The time limit for each player is 90 minutes for the whole game + 30 seconds increment for every move played, starting from the first move.

d) The FIDE Anti-Cheating rules and guidelines are valid for all Championships.

e) A player forfeits the game if he hasn't appeared at his board within 15 minutes after the start of the game.

f) Tie-break criteria: The final ranking order of the players is determined by the number of points scored. If at the end of the tournament, two or more players are tied for the first place or for any prize, the tie shall be broken in priority accordance to the following criteria for Swiss events:

1. Results of direct encounters between the tied players (applies only if all tied players have played each other).

- 2. Buchholz Cut 1.
- 3. Buchholz.
- 4. The greater number of games played with black.
- 5. The greater number of wins.

g) Appeals Procedure: appeals against decisions of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the appeals committee within **one hour** after the completion of the respective game. The protest must be accompanied with the sum of 200 €, as a deposit from the signatory. If the appeal is granted, the sum shall be returned immediately. If the appeal is refused, the deposit is forfeited to FIDE. The appeal has to be lodged by the player. The decisions of the Appeals Committee are final.

5. Titles & Qualifications

5.1 The three (3) gold winners of the Open/Women sections receive respectively the titles of:

"2023 World Amateur Champion" for the Under 2300 section

"2023 World Amateur Champion for the Under 2000" section

"2023 World Amateur Champion for the Under 1700" section

5.2 The three (3) gold winners of the Women sections receive respectively the titles of:

"2023 World Women's Amateur Champion" for the Under 2300 section

"2023 World Women's Amateur Champion for the Under 2000" section

"2023 World Women's Amateur Champion for the Under 1700" section

5.3 The gold winners of each section for the **Under 2300**, **Under 2000** & **Under 1700** (in total 6 winners, Open and Women sections) also obtain a personal right qualification for the next FIDE World Amateur Championships, as long as they don't reach or exceed a FIDE rating of **2300**, with free accommodation in double occupancy room & full board provided from the local Organizing Committee of the FIDE World Amateur Championships **2024**.

5.4 FIDE titles shall be awarded in accordance with the current FIDE Handbook.

5.5 All players will receive certificates of participation.

7. Travel Details

Participants shall book their flights to the International Airport of Muscat (IATA code: MCT). The bus transportation from and to the Muscat airport is included in the organization package for all participants on the arrival day **(01st November 2023)** and the departure day **(11th November 2023)**. Transportation from the organizers in other dates are possible upon request with an extra charge.









8. Registration cost and deadline

8.1 The deadline for the registration is 1^{st} September 2023

8.2 Registration fee: 90 euros for each player and each accompanying official/person. The registration fee is compulsory and represents a confirmation of participation. The Registration fee includes accreditation, identification, badges, organization costs, and transportation from and to Muscat International airport (Transportation from and to Muscat airport on 01st and 11th November).

8.3 The Payment deadline is 1st September 2023

8.4 FIDE FEE: **30 euros** for each player shall be paid by FIDE member federations directly to the Organizer bank account.

9. Accommodation: (Hotel, Meals)

9.1 The Hotel reservation deadline is 1st September 2023.

9.2 For Security and organizational reasons and in accordance with FIDE tournament regulations all national delegations are obliged to use the official hotel designated by the Organizing Committee. Bookings must be done only through the organizer of the FIDE World Amateur Championship.

10. Registration procedure

All players, accompanying persons and delegation members have to register (without any objection from their national federation) before the <u>deadline</u> of 1st September 2023, together with a 50% deposit payment of the registration-accommodation package described in article (9) above. After the deadline, a late registration fee of <u>50 euros</u> per participant can be required.

11.Visa information

Players and accompanying persons who need a visa to enter Muscat, are requested to contact the Organizer **before** the **1**st **September** 2023.

1- Citizens of GCC countries (the Kingdom of Bahrain, the State of Kuwait, the State of Qatar, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates) Or who have a Residence card in these countries do not require visas to enter Oman.







2- In line with national efforts to promote and ease services for tourists visiting Oman, nationals of 103 countries and regions are exempt from entry visas for stays up to 14 days.

The countries and regions whose nationals are exempt from entry visas to the Sultanate for a period of 14 days, subject to certain requirements, are listed below.

In Oman the power plug sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the frequency is 50 Hz.



13. Temperature in November

November is one of the most comfortable times of the year in Muscat (Gulf of Oman).

The average temperature is 26°C (75°F), and the High Temperature reaches 31°C(88°F)

14. Currency

The unit of currency in Oman is the Rial Omani (OMR) which is sub-divided into 1,000 Baisas.

1 OMR = 2.596 USD

1 OMR = 2.366 EUR(rate can be change in November)
