#### **01 Participants & Registration:**

**1.1.** Tournament is open to all FIDE players in the following categories **1.1.1. Master's Tournament:** Open for players rated 2300 or higher. 1.1.2. Open Tournament: Open for all rated players rated below 2300, and above 1600. **1.1.3. Youth Tournament: Open for players born in the year 2006 and later. 1.1.4.** Considered ratings are FIDE Standard Rating List for April 2024. **1.2.** Registration is only accepted online via the following: 1.2.1. Masters Tournament: LINK. 1.2.2. Open Tournament: LINK. 1.2.3. Youth Tournament: LINK. **1.3.** Maximum number of players in each category is 200 players.

**1.4.** Last day of registration & payment is **3**<sup>rd</sup> April 2024. **1.4.1.** Late Registration fees Applied after this date. **1.4.2.** Unpaid applications are rejected automatically. **1.4.3.** Application approval/Rejection is done after 4<sup>th</sup> April 2024. 1.5. All participating players and accompanying persons accept to fully comply with the rules and regulations of the tournament, the organizer & the United Arab Emirates. **1.6.** Organizing committee reserves the right to accept or deny a participant's registration according to FIDE Rules and regulations and UAE Laws. **1.7.** Organizers Committee reserves the right to issue special approvals to include lower rated players in master's tournament.

#### **02 Number of Rounds & Time Control:**

- **2.1. 9 Rounds Swiss System.**
- **2.2. Time Control:** 90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move for the whole game. **2.3. Default Time: 30-minute delay will apply.**
- 2.4. Draw Offer: Players cannot offer or agree to a draw before 30 moves are played on the board by both players.

#### 05 Prizes & winners:

5.2. Main Prizes will be awarded based on Hort-System for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place in MASTER and OPEN section and 1<sup>st</sup> – 3rd place in YOUTH section. 5.3. Other Main Prizes and Special Prizes will be awarded based on Tie-Break and will not be shared.

5.4. A player may not receive more than one prize. In cases where a participant qualifies for different awards, the prize with the higher monetary value will be awarded, and any remaining prize will be given to the next-ranked player. **5.5.** Money prize Winners MUST BE PRESENT at the Closing Ceremony. 5.6. Players who are not present at the Closing Ceremony are not eligible to obtain a money prize. 5.7. Prize winners must adhere to a business casual, elegant casual, or smart casual

dress code. Shorts and slippers are not allowed.

#### **06 Hotel Accommodation:**

**6.1.** All participants must stay in one of our two official hotels. **6.2.** The official hotels will be decided later.





#### **07 Hosting Condition:**

7.1. Grandmasters with a standard Elo of 2700+ may apply for free single-room accommodation and \$800 compensation for an air ticket by submitting the condition form. subject to FIDE rating list of April 2024, and approval.
7.2. Grandmasters with a standard Elo of 2600-2699 may apply for free single-room accommodation by submitting the condition form. subject to FIDE rating list 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024, and approval.
7.3. Last day of accepting Accommodation & compensation for Air Ticket Condition applicants is 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
7.4. The organizer will accept a limited number of Condition applicants.
7.5. Applying for accommodation does not automatically make the player eligible to get a condition.
7.6. If a participant's application for accommodation condition was accepted, the organizer will contact the player directly with an official form to be signed and returned as instructed through the email.

#### **10 Additional Rules:**

**10.1.** All players are expected to adhere to the dress code (business casual, elegant casual, or smart casual dress code, shorts and slippers are not allowed) at all times during the event. This includes the playing hall and awards ceremony. Participants who do not comply with the dress code regulations may face penalties from the organizing committee.

**10.2.** Smoking is forbidden in the playing hall.

**10.3**. After each game, players must submit the original score sheets, signed by both players, to the arbiter.

**10.4**. Players who have finished their games shall be considered as spectators and are not allowed to stay in the playing area.

**10.5.** Players are asked not to bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices (even switched off) into the playing hall. Bringing any device to the playing hall will result in forfeit.

**10.6.** The arbiter may require the player to allow his clothes, bags, or other items to be inspected, in private. The arbiter or a person authorized by the arbiter for inspection

shall be of the same gender as the player. If a player refuses to cooperate with these obligations, the arbiter shall take measures in accordance with Article 12.9. of the Laws of Chess.

10.7. Random checks of players may be carried out before and after every game.
10.8. Fair Play measures will be taken according to the FIDE Anti cheating regulations.
10.9. The players shall take no action that will bring the game of chess into disrepute.
10.10. Players are obliged to obey Tournament Regulations.
10.11. Pictures may be only taken with flash during the first ten minutes of the rounds.
After that, only Media representatives holding an accreditation are allowed to film or photograph in the playing hall.

**10.12**. Only players and arbiters shall be allowed in the actual playing area. Exceptions may only be granted by the Tournament Organizer and Chief Arbiter.
